LERNER CO-OP PROGRAM



The Lerner Co-op Program is an exclusive 9-12 month paid experience for undergraduate students enrolled in the Lerner College of Business and Economics at the University of Delaware. Designed in partnership with the Delaware Workforce Development Board, the program bridges the gap between academic learning and practical work experience, while providing Delaware employers with access to talent.

TIMELINE

The co-op spans up to one year, typically from June 1 – May 31. Students can work up to 40 hours in the summer and winter (January) and up to 20 hours in the Fall and Spring semesters.

OUALIFIED CANDIDATES

The program is open to students enrolled in the Lerner College of Business and Economics entering into their junior or senior year. Skill sets and experience include accounting, analytics, business information systems, customer service, event planning, hospitality, finance, HR, operations, marketing, sales and more.
